The highest mountain in Japan is the 'Mount Fuji' or 'Fujiyama'. Its name means everlasting life'. It is 12, 388 feet high. Mount Fuji is actually a volcano. It 's lastly erupted in 1707. It lies near the pacific Ocean on the island of Honshu, Tokyo. The most eye-catching feature of the 'Mount Fuji' is that the top section is covered with ice and its shape is highly symmetrical.

This mountain is the Japan's most popular tourist attraction. Climbing mountain fuji is considered as a religious practice. Many Japanese believed that the Mountain Fuji is sacred.
